### Online Registration Steps:

1. Log onto [www.MyArmyLifeToo.com](http://www.MyArmyLifeToo.com). If not already registered, click on **Register** and follow registration steps.
2. Once you are logged onto the site click on **'Become a Volunteer'** under **Volunteer Center** and follow registration directions.
